

HONOURABLE DATO' SRI REEZAL MERICAN BIN NAINA MERICAN

The Honourable Dato' Sri Reezal Merican Bin Naina Merican was born in Kepala Batas, Pulau Pinang on 29th July 1972. He received his secondary education at Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Agama Al-Mashoor, Pulau Pinang and went on to study atthe International Islamic University, Malaysia majoring in Arabic Languange and Literature.

Dato' Sri Reezal began his career in the banking industry before getting actively involved in politics and NGOs in the year 2000. His positions in UMNO include Exco-Member of UMNO Youth, Malaysia (2004 – 2008), UMNO Youth Information Chief Malaysia/Barisan Nasional (2008 – 2013), UMNO Division Chief Kepala Batas, Pulau Pinang and member of UMNO Supreme Council (2013 – present).

In the HGO sphere, Dato' Sri Reezal has served as President of Gabungan Pelajar Melayu Semenanjung (GPMS) (2004-2008) and currently serves as advisor to GPMS. He is also on the Board of Directors for Malaysia Prihatin.

He has served in numerous Govenrment positions, including as Political Secretary to the Minister of Women, Family & Community Development (2000-2003), Political Secretary to the Prime Minister (2008-2009).

Dato' Sri Reezal Merican currently serves as Deputy Minister of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Malaysia.

ASSOC, PROF. DR. P. SUNDRAMOORTHY

Dr. P. Sundramoorthy is an associate professor of criminology and has been working as a faculty member in the School of Social Sciences at University Sains Malaysia since June 1994. Currently, he holds the position of Director of Security at Universiti Sains Malaysia. He also heads the Research Team on Crime & Policing at Universiti Sains Malaysia. He was appointed to the Board of Assessors as an expert in the area of Criminology by the Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA) in 2011.

In 2010, he (as the principle investigator) and his co-researchers successfully completed a comprehensive consultation project on "The Root Causes of Crime in Malaysia" which was funded by the Ministry of Finance for the Government of Malaysia. Previous research projects headed by Dr. P. Sundramoorthy includes; "Public Perception on Crime Survey" and "Public Perception on Policing Survey". Currently, he is the principal investigator for a study on "Public Perception of Safety" which is fully funded by PEMANDU NKRA Crime


In 2003, Sundramoorthy was invited as a Visiting Professor to University of Utah (USA), where he taught a course in "Comparative Criminal Justice of United States of America and Malaysia". In 2002, he was invited as a Visiting Professor to Chubu University in Nagoya, Japan. Since 1996, Sundramoorthy serves as executive member on the Malaysia Crime Prevention Foundation (Penang).

In October 2010, the Prime Minister of Malaysia appointed Sundramoorthy as an executive member of the Malaysia Crime Prevention Foundation (Federal). From February 2015 to February 2016 he was appointed by the Prime Minister to serve on the Malaysia Anti-Corruption Commission's Operations Review Panel. He is also serves as the elected President of the Academic and Administrative Association of USM. In 2014, he was also appointed as an Associate Editor by the Minister of Home Affairs for the Journal of Public Security and Safety, Institute of Public Security of Malaysia (IPSOM). Since 2014, he was appointed as a Counselor in the Asian Criminological Society.

PROFESSOR DR. JOMO KWAME SUNDARAM

Professor Dr Jomo Kwame Sundaram also known as Jomo is a Malaysian born in Penang and named after two African anti colonial leaders. A prominent Malaysian Economist. He studied locally in Westlands Primary School and went along to Penang Free Schools before his acceptance into the Royal Military College where he was then selected as Malaysia's Delegate to the World Youth Forum back in the 1970's.

He pursued his studies in Yale majoring in economics then received his MBA from Harvard. Later returning to his homeland teaching in the University Science Malaysia(USM). With his thirst for knowledge, Jomo returned to Harvard to complete his doctorate while teaching in Yale. In mid-1982, Jomo moved to University of Malaya, where he remained until 2004.

He was a British Academy Visiting Professor and later Visiting Fellow at Cambridge, a Fullbright Visiting Professor at Cornell University and Visiting Senior Research Fellow at the Asia Research Institute of Singapore. Jomo has served as the United Nations Assistant Secretary General for Economic Development (DESA) from 2005 until 2012. He was then appointed as Assistant Director General and Coordinator for economic and Social Development in the Food and Agriculture Development. Not only serving with the United Nations, he also was a Founder Chair of International Development Economics Associate (IDEAs) and sat on the board of the United Nations Research Institute for Social Development(UNRISD) in Geneva.

In 2007 he was awarded the Wassily Leontief Prize and in the term of 2008 -2009 he also served as adviser to the President of the 63rd United Nations General Assembly. Jomo was also a member of the Stiglitz – Commission of Experts of the President of the United Nations General Assembly on Reforms of the International Monetary and Financial System. Jomo has addressed ministerial meetings of UNCTAD, most UN regional commissions, Funds and Programmes, several UN agencies as well as ECOSOC and the General Assembly's Second, Third and Fifth Committees as well as the World Economic Forum (Davos), Global Policy Forum (Yaroslavl), World Public Forum (Rhodos), World Social Forum (Porto Alegre) and many academic, business and civil society conferences.

He is a well-known scholar and expert on the political economy development, especially in Southeast Asia who has now authored or edited over a hundred books as well as translated 12 volumes besides writing many academic papers and articles for the media.

Jomo Kwame Sundaram is on the Editorial boards of several learned journals today.
