Short presentation of HM Margareta Custodian of the Romanian Crown

Her Majesty Margareta of Romania is the Head of the House of Romania since the death of King Michael I in 2017. Although the country is governed by a republican constitution, Her Majesty is respected by the elected officials of the country, addresses the joint assembly of the Chambers of the Parliament and maintains a close collaboration with the Government for social, educational, diplomatic and economic projects. Her Majesty and the Royal Family also enjoy the affection and confidence of Romanians.

Margareta of Romania has been living in the country since 18 January 1990. Since 1997, she has been making regular public visits around the world. These visits are organized by the Romanian Government and aim at supporting the country's fundamental interests.

In particular, on the occasion of the Presidency of Romania at the Council of the European Union, Her Majesty Margareta and her husband, Prince Radu, visited Spain, Portugal, Alsace (France), Croatia and the United Kingdom. This year, they visited Denmark and France and they will visit the Netherlands.

Margareta of Romania has a university degree in sociology, political science and international law and is deeply involved in the social, educational and health fields, in her country.

She is the President of the Romanian Red Cross and the Royal Patron of the Romanian Olympic Committee. She is also the founder and President of Margareta of Romania Royal Foundation.
